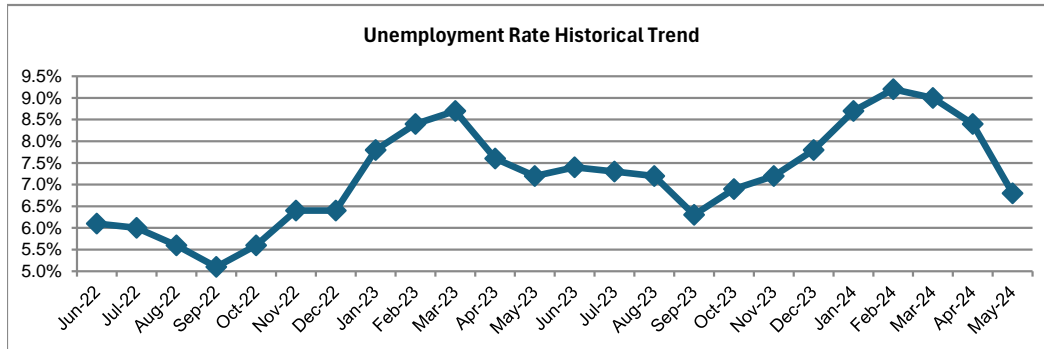


IMMEDIATE RELEASE
 MADERA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
 (Madera County)

The unemployment rate in the Madera County was 6.8 percent in May 2024, down from a revised 8.4 percent in April 2024, and below the year-ago estimate of 7.2 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.5 percent for California and 3.7 percent for the nation during the same period.
