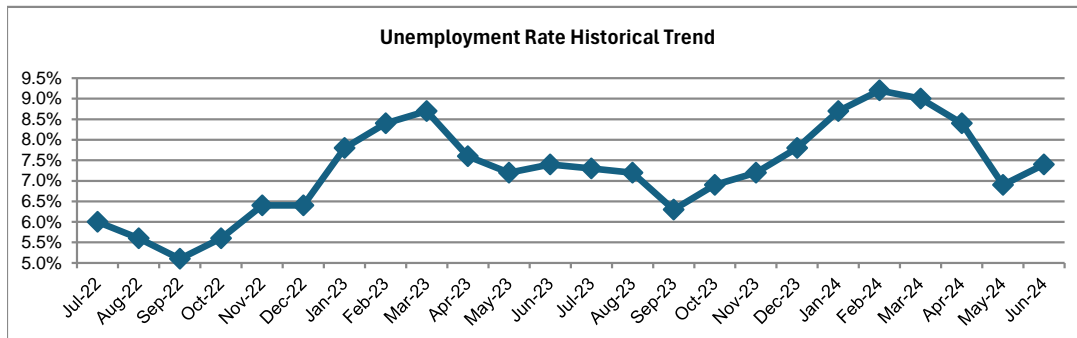


IMMEDIATE RELEASE
 MADERA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
 (Madera County)

The unemployment rate in the Madera County was 7.4 percent in June 2024, up from a revised 6.9 percent in May 2024, and unchanged the year-ago estimate of 7.4 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.3 percent for California and 4.3 percent for the nation during the same period.
